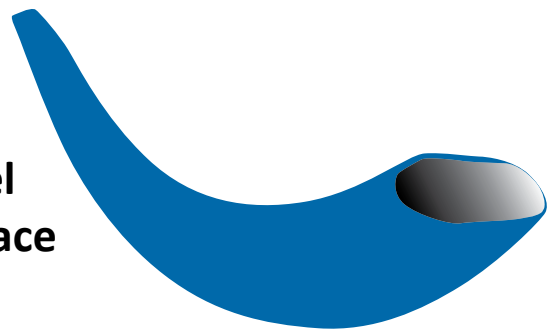

Message from the President

Dear Congregant,

Did you hear it? The shofar? Did you hear it today? It was blown. It is Elul and it is blown every day of the month, except for Shabbos, as a reminder that Tishrei, and the beginning of a new year, is on its way. I heard it, in my head and in my heart, I can hear it. Listen. You too, do you hear it?

I was recently reminded by Rabbi Neil Zuckerman, of New York's Park Avenue Synagogue, that on eleven months of the year we recite the Birkat h' Kodesh, the blessing of the new month. We recite the sacred words, asking G-d to bless us with a good life, peace, blessing, joy and gladness, honor, sustenance and prosperity, a life of health and well-being, a life in which our requests are fulfilled for the good. There is only one month in the year that we do not recite this prayer. That is the month of Tishrei. Why? Rabbi reminded us that the Birkat h'Chodesh is an announcement of a new month. For Rosh Hashanah, no announcement is necessary. We know it is a new month.

The absence of the prayer, however, creates a space for us to hear something else. For eleven months, we ask G-d what He will do for us. On Rosh Hashanah, the stage is set for us to think about what we can do for G-d. There is so much over which we have no control. But we do have choices. Those ideas are represented in the concept of t'shuvah. I eat too much. I drink too much. I don't like to exercise. I am not as generous as I might be in thought, word, or deed.

During the month of Elul, we are given a headstart to think about what is coming. The shofar is blown daily and it is a reminder that Tishrei is on the way. We have an opportunity to think about it, contemplate what we might do differently, what we would change, intentionally. It is a great gift to be able to prepare.

As we celebrate the New Year, it is my pleasure, on behalf of the Board of Trustees and the staff of Congregation Etz Chayim to wish you and yours a happy, healthy, and sweet new year, May we be written and inscribed in the book of life, of goodness, of prosperity, please G-d, and live in a world of kindness, integrity, and peace.

Boruch atta A-do-noy elohainu melech ho'olam
